

SCHOOL EMPLOYEE COVID-19 TESTING

FOR THOSE WHO ARE SYMPTOMATIC/EXPOSED

SCHOOL TESTING SITES

In accordance with guidance from the California Department of Public Health, School Testing Sites are open for Placer County school employees who are symptomatic or who have been exposed to COVID-19.

LOCATIONS AND HOURS:

The following site are open Monday-Friday from 8 a.m. - 12 p.m. and 12:30 - 2:30 p.m. by appointment only:

- PCOE Annex Nobili Conference Room, 365 Nevada St, Auburn, CA 95603
- Rideout Community Center, 740 Timberland Street, Tahoe City, CA, 96145

SCHEDULE YOUR APPOINTMENT:

WHAT TO EXPECT:

- . Bring photo ID and insurance information.
- Park in a designated testing parking spot.
- Enter the testing site at your designated time.
- A licensed medical professional will verify paperwork and administer the test.
- You will be asked to sign a waiver so that your employer and you can be notified of results within 48-72 hours.





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SCHOOL EMPLOYEE COVID-19 TESTING

SURVEILLANCE TESTING

Guidance from California Department of Public Health recommends surveillance testing for school staff based on local disease trends. In consultation with Placer County Public Health, the following testing options are available:

PRIMARY CARE PROVIDER

Contact your primary care provider to request a COVID-19 test. The California Department of Managed Care released an emergency resolution on July 17, 2020 stipulating that school employees are essential workers and therefore their healthcare provider should cover costs associated with their COVID-19 testing.

RESULTS REPORTING

After receiving test results, report the results with your school district to ensure appropriate safety measures are being taken on campus.

If you have cold-like symptoms or have been exposed to someone who tested positive for COVID-19, please schedule a COVID-19 test at a Placer County School Testing Site at www.placercoe.org/schooltestingsites.





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STUDENT COVID-19 TESTING

OPTUMSERVE TESTING SITES

Schedule your test at a location near you by visiting lhi.care/covidtesting or call (888) 634-1123. After receiving test results, report the results with your school district to ensure appropriate safety measures are being taken on campus.

ADDITIONAL TESTING OPTION FOR STUDENTS WITHOUT INSURANCE

COVID-19 testing for your student may be available through School Testing Sites by appointment only, pending availability. Make an appointment by visiting www.placercoe.org/schooltestingsites. You will be asked for photo ID and to sign a waiver so that your students school district and you can be notified of results within 48-72 hours.
